PSE&G Announces North Central Reliability Project - *T&D World*
Public Service Electric and Gas Co. will seek approval from the New Jersey Board of Utilities for the North Central Reliability Project, which would upgrade transmission lines and substations from existing 138kV power to 230kV power in the northern and central regions of the state. The upgrade is required by the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C., the independent regional planning organization.
